



UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS 2017

Belts

Are required to be worn by Senior School students with trousers or shorts. They must be black with a plain buckle.

Blazers

Are part of both the summer and winter uniform for Year 9 to 12. They must be worn to and from school on all days except when the morning forecast is 26 degrees or above. Blazers must be worn when attending assemblies, representing the school and taking part in excursions.

Dress and Skirt Length

Must rest on or below the knee.

Hats

Must be worn during recess and lunch in Term 1 and 4.

Scarves (Optional)

Must be navy (Prep to Year 8) or maroon (Year 9 to 12).

Shoes

Must be plain, black, leather school shoes with laces.

Shorts

Are only to be worn in Term 1 and 4.

Shirts

That are straight cut can be worn as part of the summer uniform. All shirts must be tucked in during the winter terms.

Socks

Must be grey for boys. All girls wear short white socks in summer (no anklets). Junior School girls wear long white socks or navy tights in winter.

Ties

Must be worn by Year 9 to 12 students in Term 2 and 3.

Tights

Are required to be worn by all Junior, Middle and Senior girls in winter. They must be navy and opaque. Socks may not be worn over tights.

Students without the correct uniform may be given a detention or excluded from classes, excursions, special events or school photographs.
